About Riverfront Recapture

Riverfront Recapture is a nonprofit (501c3) organization dedicated to managing, operating, maintaining, and activating four connected parks spanning nearly 170 acres along 3.5 miles of the Connecticut River. For 42 years, we have been fulfilling our mission to connect people with the Connecticut River, enhancing quality of life and making our region a better place to live, work, and play.

Since 1981, Riverfront Recapture has led efforts to create vibrant riverfront spaces, offering year-round access to parks, a robust calendar of seasonal events and programming, and one of New England's largest community rowing programs, which provides free rowing opportunities for Hartford and East Hartford youth. Our commitment to expanding access continues with the acquisition of 60 acres on the Hartford-Windsor line to develop a new community park.

We actively seek partnerships with businesses, foundations, performance groups, and nonprofits to engage more people with our parks, events, and programs. Learn more about our work at riverfront.org.

Our Programs

Riverfront Rowing

Our Community Rowing Program is one of the largest and most successful in New England. We offer recreational and competitive classes year-round for people of all experience levels, from pre-teens to retirees. Participants also have the opportunity to compete on nationally recognized racing teams. The high school rowing program, which draws students from 33 schools, is free for East Hartford and Hartford residents. Our rowing program hosts the largest single day regatta in Connecticut, and one of the top five in New England each October, the Head of the Riverfront.

Dragon Boating

In addition to the annual Riverfront Dragon Boat and Asian Festival, held each August, we offer dragon boating classes during the summer. These classes cater to paddlers of all skill levels. For experienced paddlers, we have two teams that compete in races across the region.

Our Parks

Riverfront Recapture manages, operates, maintains, and activates four connected parks along the Connecticut River.

Charter Oak Landing, 50 Reserve Road, Hartford, CT

Charter Oak Landing, located just south of downtown Hartford, is a haven for outdoor enthusiasts and families. The park features a public boat launch, making it a popular destination for fishing and exploring the Connecticut River. Families can enjoy the playground, scenic picnic areas, and tranquil river views. Paved and lighted riverwalks encourage peaceful strolls, and free parking ensures convenient access to this vibrant riverside retreat.



Great River Park, 301 East River Drive, East Hartford, CT

Great River Park blends cultural charm with natural beauty along the Connecticut River. Its amphitheater and public sculptures make it a hub for arts and performances, while picnic tables and almost two miles of paved, lighted riverwalks cater to leisurely outings. Visitors can explore wooded trails, exercise stations, and take in skyline views. A public boat launch provides easy river access, and pedestrians can connect with downtown Hartford via the Founders Bridge Promenade. This park's unique mix of art, nature, and recreation makes it a favorite for all ages.



Mortensen Riverfront Plaza, 300 Columbus Boulevard, Hartford, CT

Mortensen Riverfront Plaza, a striking part of Hartford's skyline, offers a seamless mix of urban vibrancy and riverfront beauty. The grass terraces provide seating for up to 2,500 attendees enjoying performances on the Hartford HealthCare Community Stage, while the upper and lower plazas come alive during signature events. The park is easily walkable, with the Founders Bridge Promenade linking downtown Hartford to East Hartford. Paved walkways and public art enhance the experience, making the plaza a perfect escape in the heart of the city.



Riverside Park, 20 Leibert Road, Hartford, CT

Riverside Park offers something for everyone with its rich blend of recreation and nature. Home to the boathouse, community rowing program, and dragon boat program, the park features docks, a boat launch, and athletic fields for cricket, and volleyball. Families can enjoy playgrounds, picnic areas with grills, and scenic riverfront trails enhanced by public art. Riverside Park's diverse amenities and lively atmosphere make it a destination for adventure and relaxation.

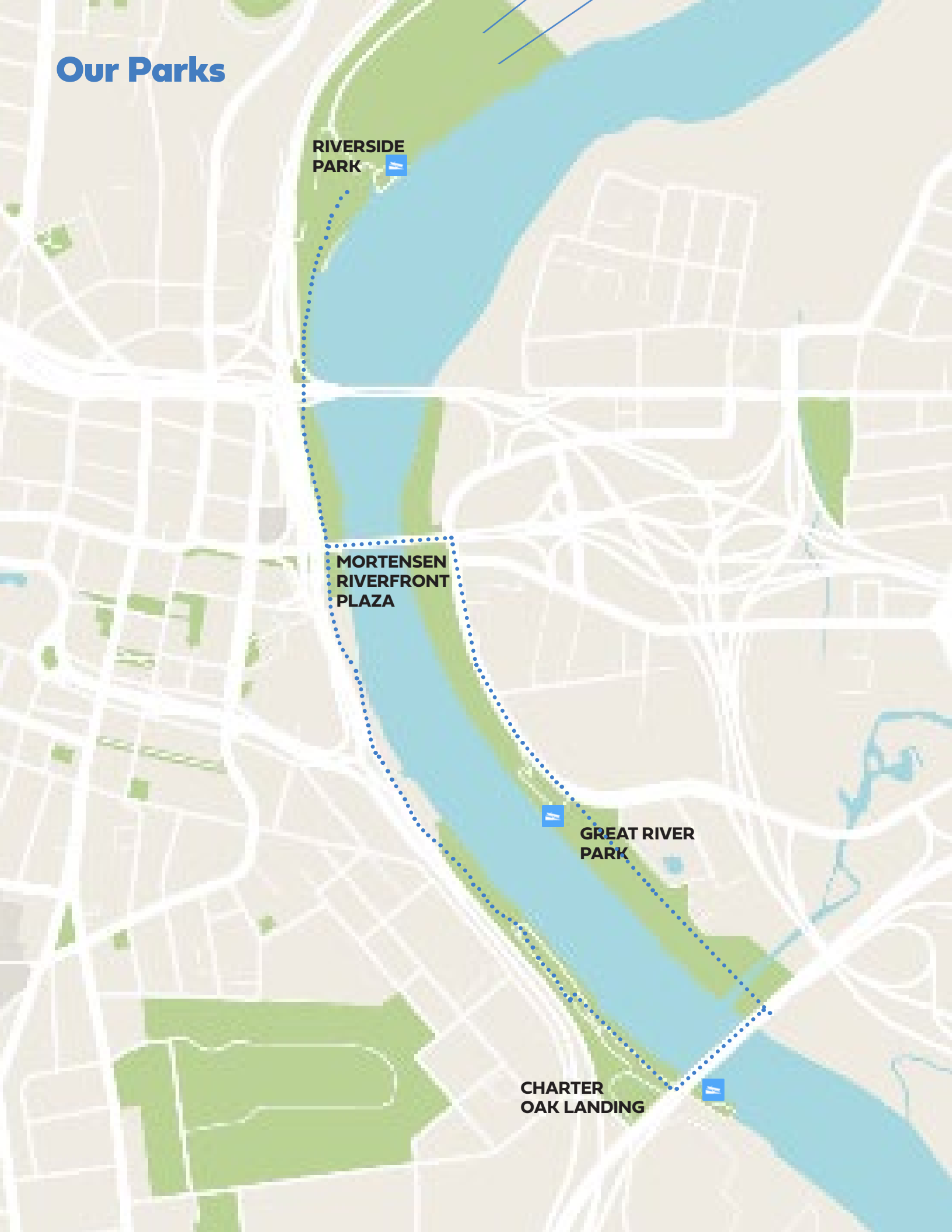


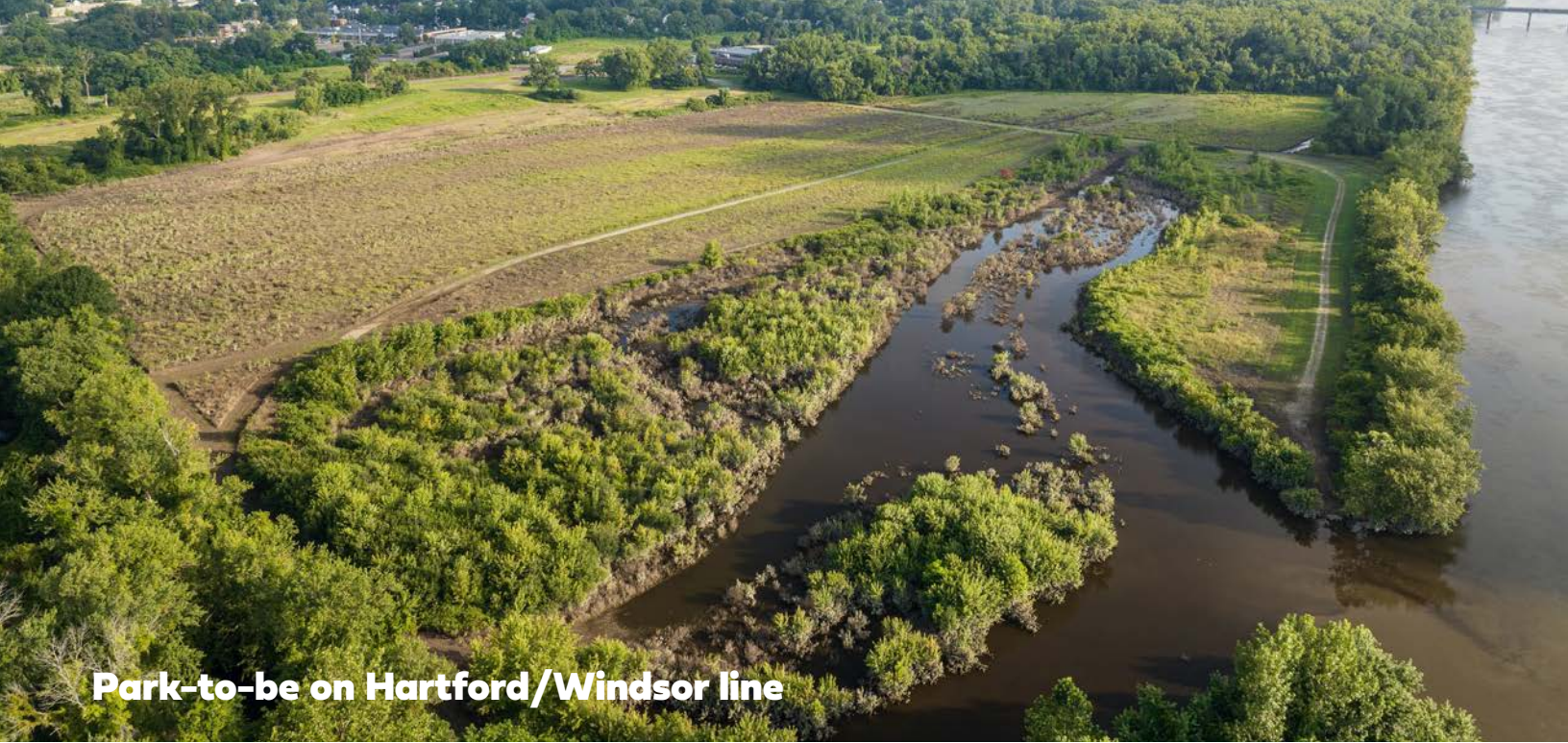
